Hi Everyone,

Receiving my Level 4 Certificate of Completion and becoming an HTI Practitioner Apprentice was a victory but I knew the real work was just about to begin. How and where would I find clients to document 100 therapy sessions? This was going to be a challenge but I was determined.

I went through my contact list from the local hospitals where I volunteered, fundraised, or otherwise knew people in the medical field. My first call would be to Sheila Kussner, health care activist, consummate volunteer and Founder of the Hope and Cope Wellness Centre affiliated with the Montreal Jewish General Hospital. For decades Sheila has been dedicated to providing emotional and psychosocial support to cancer patients and their families. I was nervous and felt rather intimidated by her status as the 'true grande dame' in this city among the who's who crowd but I decided to look at the big picture, put my fears aside, and make the call. I told Mrs. Kussner what I had been studying and what I would like to offer Hope and Cope. She loved the idea and put me in touch with Suzanne O'Brien the Executive Director. We made an appointment to meet at the hospital. I brought pertinent information about Healing Touch and its benefits for Cancer Care 'survivors' and other relevant work history in my professional and informative portfolio. I was called back for two more interviews with various members of the board and had to do a therapy session with a volunteer while people watched and critiqued. They told me that they would let the director know their opinion and gave no indication either way. The volunteer was enthusiastic and had left wanting more so even though I didn't get any feedback from the others, I felt confident and my intuitive side gave me a thumbs up. After 10 days or so I got the call saying they would be pleased to have me on board.

It sounds like a lot of protocol for volunteer work but I understand the conservative views of the Jewish General, as well as the other world renowned Montreal Hospitals, in accepting Energy Medicine as part of their practice. With special care and particular attention to detail, the Centre's Coordinator and Manager Marcelle Kecman made it all happen.

What I learned very quickly was that time management was paramount. The Centre scheduled 1 'survivor' every 30 minutes. This was too fast paced and left me little to no time to document, wash hands, change pillow cases, and get water. After a month we changed it to 1 every 45 minutes. Each 'survivor' is scheduled for 3 consecutive weeks. This allows me to get feedback and to change techniques and offer support according to each assessment. I do not have time to be nervous; I 'just do the work' as Janet Mentgen would say.

This opportunity is teaching me how to adapt to the various challenges as they present themselves from week to week. Learning ways to be more efficient with the time allowed and the opportunity to give and receive the energy right back has been such a gift. It will influence my future as both a Healing Touch Practitioner and as a member of the community. I feel blessed and grateful that at this juncture I have found my purpose in life.

To end this first chapter, I will say that there was a Plan B. I had sent my packet to the Royal Victoria Hospital Volunteer Department as well. They called me for an interview after 2 months but I had to decline.



If you are passionate and believe in what you are doing, don't stop until someone says YES. You will succeed. I have not made any financial gains yet with my craft as a Healing Touch Practitioner Apprentice but I can tell you this, the happiness I get from seeing the hope, gratitude, and love in the eyes of the
